


How to Join PulpFest 2019

A prepaid, full-weekend membership to *PulpFest* 2019 costs \$35 for members staying at the DoubleTree. Additionally, to reward these loyal attendees who help to defray the convention's substantial costs by staying at our host hotel, *PulpFest* is happy to offer free early-bird shopping on Thursday, August 15, from 4 to 8 PM. PulpFest 2019 Programming

PulpFest 2019 will focus on "Children of the Pulps and Other Stories," an examination of the pervasive influence of pulp magazines on pop culture. Over the years, these throwaway magazines have inspired creators around the globe.

Beginning on Thursday evening and running through Saturday night, we'll have presentations on science fiction, men's adventure magazines, Zorro, Fritz Leiber's Fafhrd & the Gray Mouser, Sherlock Holmes, authors Dashiell Hammett, Arthur J. Burks, Philip José Farmer, and Charles Beaumont, pulps into film, and women pulp artists. The convention will also show rarely seen Fu Manchu films, hosted by William Patrick Maynard.

We'll be profiling all of our programming from May 6 through June 10 at <u>pulpfest.com</u>.

One of the highlights of this year's programming will be a salute to the 60th anniversary of Rod Serling's

Registering at the Door

Our registration desk will be open on Thursday, August 15, from 4 to 8 PM, and Friday, August 16, from 9 AM until 4:45 PM. On Saturday and Sunday, the desk will be open during our regular business hours.

If you have prepaid for your membership, you will be able to pick up your convention materials at this time. If you will be paying at the door, a full weekend membership will cost \$40. You'll be able to pay for your registration at the door using cash, check, or credit card. If possible, please bring along a pre-filled registration form.

Selling at PulpFest 2019

All dealers and their helpers must be registered members of PulpFest 2019. Additionally, it will cost \$90 for island tables and \$100 for wall tables. Wall tables and positioning within the dealers' room will be sold on a first-come, first-served basis. Our dealers' room



holds 100+ six-foot-long tables. Displays will be allowed on all tables as long as they can stand safely. If you have any special needs — electrical outlets, room positioning, early departure, and so on — let us know when you register for the convention.

Although the focus of Pulp-*Fest* is pulp magazines and related materials, vintage paperbacks, digests, men's adventure and true crime magazines, genre fiction, first-edition hardcovers, series books, dime novels, original art, Big Little Books, Golden and Silver Age comic books, old-time-

radio shows, gaming materials, and film serials, B-movies, and related collectibles will also be available for sale. Sexually explicit material, including PLAYBOY, PENTHOUSE, and OUI, will not be allowed. PulpFest's dealers' room will be open to our dealers for setup

There will be more than 30 fiction writers attending PulpFest 2019. Most of them will be reading from their work or participating in panels on writing.

PulpFest 2019 will host 10 readings by contemporary authors of pulp fiction and a panel featuring John Bruening, Christopher Paul Carey, and Will Murray — author of "The All-New Wild Adventures of Doc Savage and Tarzan."

Particularly noteworthy will be Raw Dog Screaming Press's Sweet Sixteen Celebration. The publisher will host a "Rapid-Fire Read" on both Friday and Saturday mornings. Join the authors of this small press "dedicated to putting into print the highest quality literature from the fringe," as they read from their work.

On Saturday morning, PulpFest will be also host four genre writers from the Seton Hill University "Writing Popular Fiction Graduate Program." They'll be introduced by novelist Heidi Ruby Miller.

Book a Room at the DoubleTree

For our 48th annual convention, PulpFest will return to the DoubleTree by Hilton Hotel Pittsburgh – Cranberry. Nineteen miles north of Pittsburgh, the DoubleTree is conveniently located at the intersection of Interstate 79, the Pennsylvania Turnpike, and State Route 19. If you're flying into Pittsburgh International Airport, the DoubleTree is located about 35 miles from the airport.

Our host hotel is at 910 Sheraton Drive, Mars, Pennsylvania. For driving directions, click the link under "Map to Hotel" on our home page. Parking at the hotel is free.

The best deal for *PulpFest* members is to book a room at the DoubleTree. Our host hotel offers a daily rate of \$129 plus tax. This rate includes two complimentary breakfasts per room and free wifi for each day at the hotel. Attendees who don't want to go elsewhere for meals or libations can take advantage of the Ember & Vine, the hotel's world-class restaurant and bar.

You must register by July 31 and mention *PulpFest* to get the convention rate. We urge every member to book a room as soon as possible. The earlier you place your reservation for this year's *PulpFest*, the greater chance you have of landing a room at the DoubleTree.

PulpFest 2019 Auction

On Saturday evening, August 17, PulpFest 2019 will host a collectibles auction. All members of the convention can submit items to sell at auction. All auction lots must have a \$20 minimum value. If you plan to offer an auction lot with a reserve price, your reserve must be \$50 or more. PulpFest reserves the right to reject any auction material that does not meet its standards.

The convention charges sellers 10% of the selling price for anything sold at auction. If a reserve price is placed on an auction lot and it fails to sell, there will be no charge applied.
